Adoption Statement

South Worcestershire Planning for Health Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

Subject Matter and Area Covered: The Health and Wellbeing Supplementary Planning Document will cover the administrative areas of Malvern Hills District, Worcester City, and Wychavon District. The Health and Wellbeing Supplementary Planning Document sets out guidance relating to the consideration of health and wellbeing matters when determining planning applications. Notice is hereby given that:

- a) On 18 July 2017 Malvern Hills District Council agreed to adopt the Health and Wellbeing Supplementary Planning Document with effect from 21 September 2017.
- b) On 10 July 2017 Worcester City Council agreed to adopt the Health and Wellbeing Supplementary Planning Document with effect from 21 September 2017.
- c) On 20 September 2017 Wychavon District Council agreed to adopt the Health and Wellbeing Supplementary Planning Document with effect from 21 September 2017.
- d) That any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision.
- e) That any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after 21 September 2017, which is when the SPD was adopted.
