

SWDPR Regulation 19 Publication Interactive Map User Guide

The SWDPR interactive map includes all policies contained in the Development Plan as well as other useful datasets. Its purpose is to help the public understand the policies relevant to any parcel of land in the South Worcestershire area.

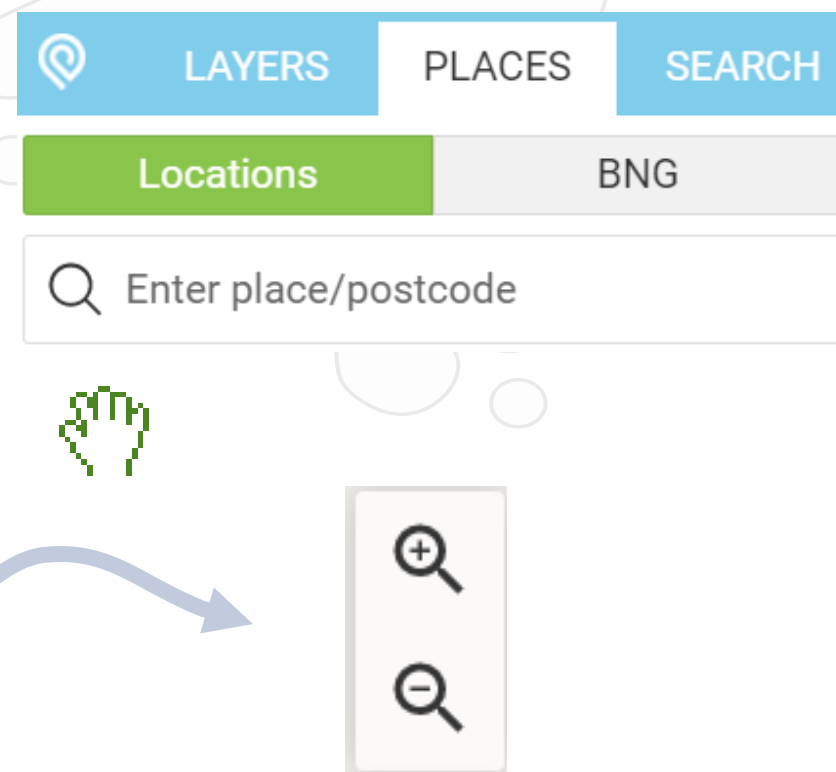
Navigating the map

Once you have read and closed the initial information pop-up you will find that, like most mapping tools, there are several different ways of navigating:

Make sure 'PLACES' is selected at the top left corner of the page. Then you can enter a place name or postcode into the box and click on the location name underneath.

To move around the map click and drag with the hand cursor. You can also move around the map by using your arrow keys.

To zoom in and out you can either use your mouse wheel or click on the zoom buttons on the right hand side of the page.



Policies

The next step is to see what layers are switched on. To view these click on the 'LAYERS' tab at the top left corner of the page. Make sure 'SWDPR Reg 19 Policies Mapping Layers' is ticked.

You can turn on / off any of the layers in this list.

To find out about any particular map feature make sure that the information tool is selected from the icons in the top right corner of the page.

When you click on a map feature a text bubble will pop up with relevant information about that site. This can be used to refer back to the SWDPR policies in the main document.
