

Traveller and Travelling Showpeople 'Call for Sites' Site Submission Form - Oct 2020

The South Worcestershire Councils (Malvern Hills, Worcester and Wychavon) are preparing a Traveller and Travelling Showpeople Site Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD) that will identify land to meet the requirement to accommodate Travellers and Travelling Showpeople across south Worcestershire.

As part of this process, the South Worcestershire Councils are undertaking a further "Call for Sites" exercise which provides an opportunity for individuals, agents, landowners and developers to suggest sites that they consider might be suitable to allocate in the DPD. Proposals could be for either new sites or an expansion or intensification of an existing site. Proposals are invited for permanent residential sites or transit sites / temporary stopping places. Sites within the Green Belt, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty or liable to flood will not normally be acceptable.

Please complete this form if you (as the landowner / landowner's agent or developer) wish to put forward land for a Traveller or Travelling Showpeople site within south Worcestershire i.e. the administrative areas of Worcester City Council, Malvern Hills District Council and Wychavon District Council.

Please note: There is **no** need to submit any sites that you previously submitted to either of the previous 2 "call for sites" or where you have written to ask for a site to be considered through the Site Allocations DPD process unless you wish to make any changes to previously submitted sites (for example site area, land ownership, new access), or wish to withdraw any site(s) from further consideration.

- Provide a **site location plan** at 1:1250 or 1:2500. An OS plan can be purchased at: https://www.planningportal.co.uk/homepage/4/buy_a_planning_map. Without this mapping information, we are unable to register the site.
